**Customs Import Processing Charges effective 1<sup>st</sup> July 2014**

The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries & Forestry (DAFF) have revised the Customs Import Processing charges per below this is due to increases levied by quarantine on each Import Declaration and collected by Customs

These changes will take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2014.

**Biosecurity Quarantine processing fee:** was \$49.00 now \$50.00

This is for all Import Declarations submitted to Quarantine.

**Tailgate (manned depot):** was \$89.00 now \$90.00

**Tailgate (unmanned depot):** was \$139.00 now \$140.00

**Air Import Declarations:**

**For air freight shipment valued from \$1,000.00 to \$9,999.99:**

Import processing charge was \$55.20 now \$56.20

**For air freight shipment valued from \$10,000.00 upwards:**

Import processing charge was \$137.10 now \$138.10

---

**Sea Import Declarations:**

**For sea freight shipment valued from \$1,000.00 to \$9,999.99:**

Import processing charge for LCL was \$70.00 now \$73.00

Import processing charge for FCL was \$88.00 now \$95.00

**For sea freight shipment valued from \$10,000.00 upwards:**

Import processing charge for LCL was \$172.60 now \$175.60

Import processing charge for FCL was \$190.60 now \$197.60 (for one FCL, for each additional FCL was \$24.00 now \$30.00 per FCL)

**The DAFF (AQIS) charges do not cover quarantine clearance. It is only a charge for each Import Declaration as revenue for DAFF. Quarantine fees are applicable for goods requiring the lodgement of documents to DAFF for processing.**
